Subject: West Apron Rehabilitation – Nieuport Construction

Starting on Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> 2023 at 23:00 Nieuport Aviation will begin rehabilitation of the southern part of the west apron (see Diagrams below). This work will continue for 4 nights, 23:00 – 06:00 each night, weather permitting, ending on Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup> at 06:00. This work will not impact the Fuel Bowser/Truck services and all pavement surfaces will be returned to normal for the next morning operations.

Area 1 – July 24; Area 2 – July 25; Area 3 – July 26; Area 4 – July 27

All apron markings, lead-in lines, CRA, (Including ‘Restricted Area’) will be repainted before start of aircraft movements the following morning. A small part of the vehicle corridor close to the Terminal Building and to the Porter Hangar will be renovated, (to include ‘Restricted Area’).

Security personnel will be escorting the work crews and all safety precautions will be taken. The ferry will be required to run overnight for four nights to deliver asphalt. Construction vehicles will be arriving Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> evening between 20:30 and 22:30.
